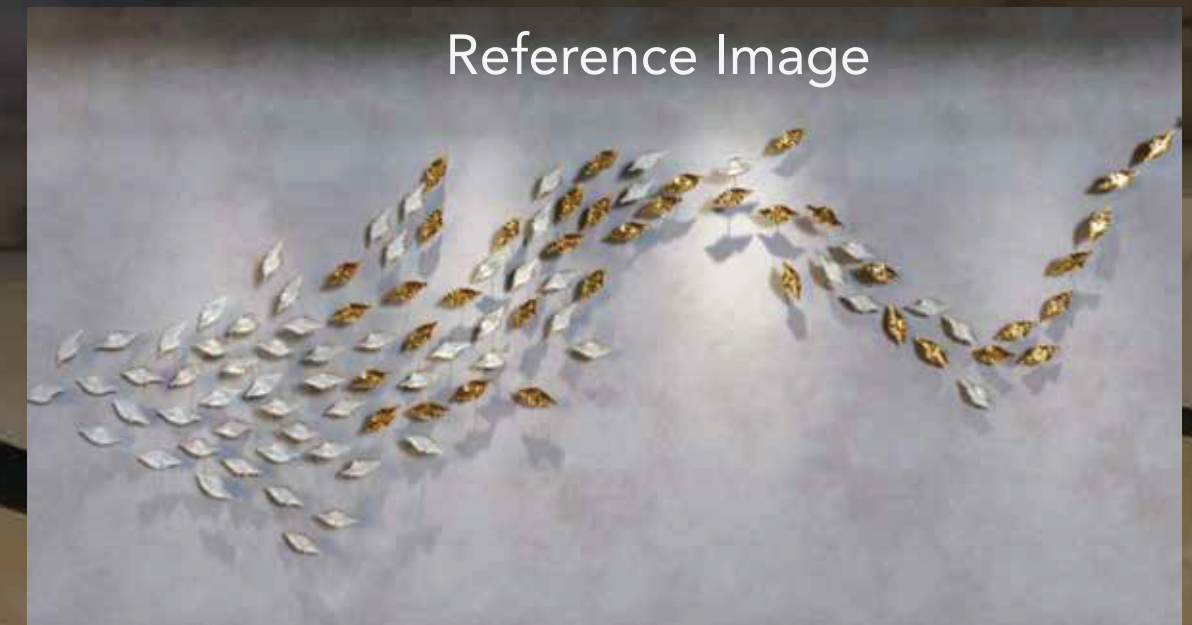


This concept makes use of the traditional mughal artistic element referred to as Pietra Dura, which makes use of stone inlays into marble.

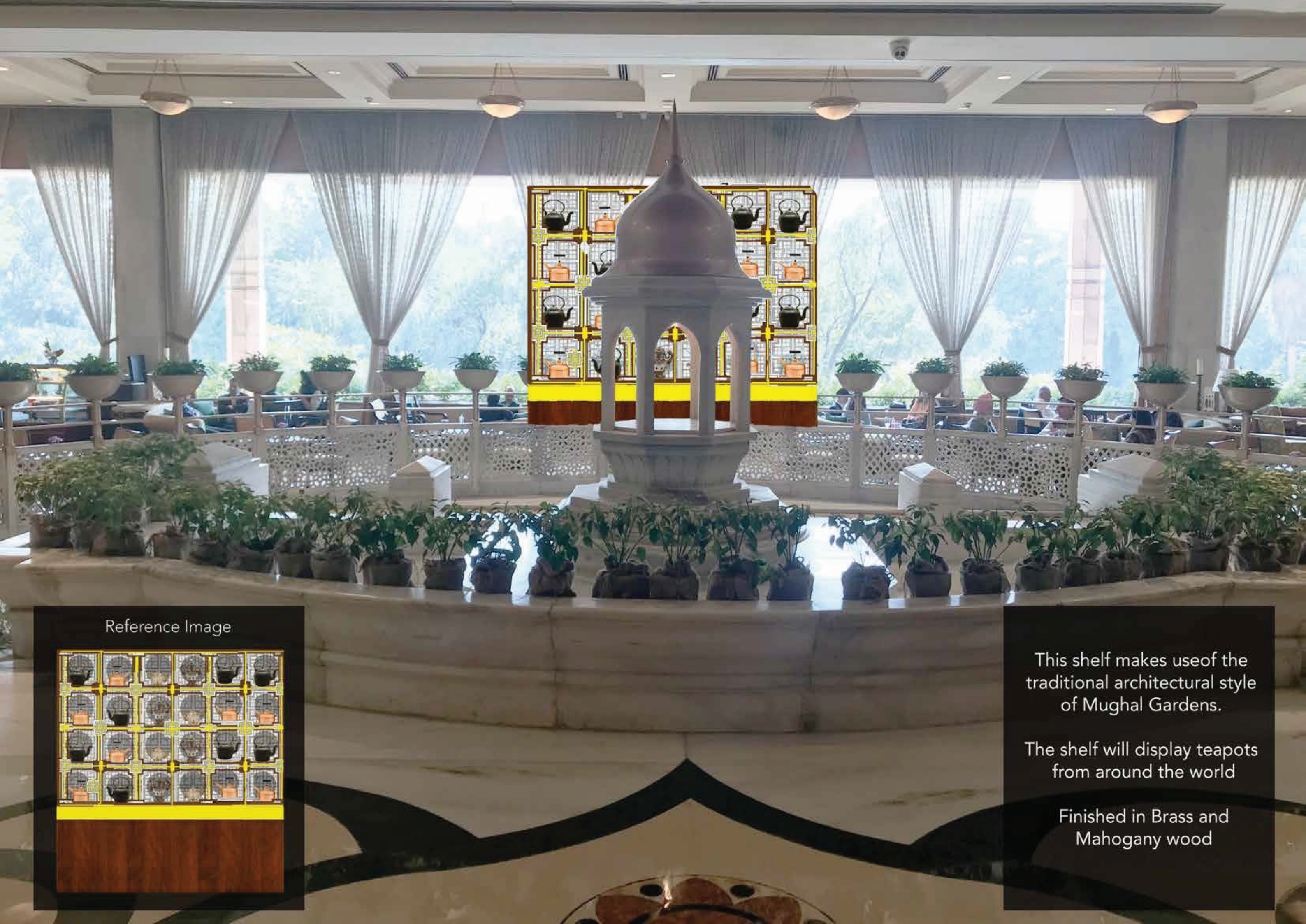
