Brief and Background



The year was 2009, when the property was first conceived. That much is visible in the style of the elevation, which takes heavy influence from Spanish Architecture, Indian-ised to an era specific to a liberal use of wooden finishes, glass railings, and a celebration of beige.

Keeping the structure the same, the design of the place was due for change. Two directions were discussed, both of which are discussed ahead.

Option 1 - Classical Restyling



One idea was to use a restrained re-interpretation of classical architecture, primarily to celebrate the grace of fluted columns.

Other elements to stay true to form, included cast iron railings, use of traditional marble flooring, and heavy dependence on wall lighting, opposed to ceiling lighting.

Option 2 - French Retro Chic



This theme, was an expolation, which also though not contemporary, provided a much more modern touch. An elegant crossroads between elegant restraint, and quiet boldness.

This is the concept that won.
